



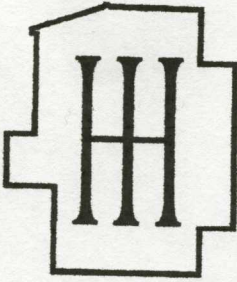

A 20th CENTURY HERITAGE HOME was built between the years 1901 and 1930. It has its original style and features, both inside and out, substantially maintained or restored. It must be physically located in Tuscarawas County, Ohio.

___ 1. As originally built with or without "improvements" (plumbing, heating, electricity). Any improvement must be made with the original flavor of the era maintained or done in good taste with the changing of times. The structure shall be kept in excellent condition.

___ 2. Virtually original with improvements (kitchen or bath). Looks very much like the original in both exterior and interior. Changes allowed in exterior and interior, if minor, and in keeping with the original character and style of the house.

___ 3. Basic lines, design, room arrangements mostly intact. Interior or exterior is somewhat remodeled, modernized, or obscured, but not to such a degree that the original cannot be restored. Additions are acceptable if done in such a manner that the basic lines and style of the home are unaltered.

C. INFORMATION REGARDING THE BUILDING: Provide as much of the following as possible. Use separate sheets of paper if necessary.

1. Evidence proving year of construction, with information regarding owners from the original to you. (See Deed Records and Grantor-Grantee Indexes in the County Recorder's office, your Abstract, Tuscarawas Co. Historical Society Archives at Kent State University Branch.) If the house is believed to predate 1900, ask for old ledgers using 5-10 year spans in the County Auditor's office. Other sources would be newspaper accounts of the building or families who occupied it; written statements in letters, diaries, etc., by owners or occupants of the building; interviews with persons in a position to verify date of construction. (Reference Books: A Field Guide to American Houses by McAlester & McAlester; Identifying American Architecture by John G. Blumenson. These and other reference books are available in the Tuscarawas Co. Public Library.)

2. Events occurring in the building. If it served as a tavern, mill, factory, church, stage house or other, please provide details.

3. If you apply on the basis of a notable occupant, please provide said occupant's contributions to the history of Tuscarawas County, Ohio, or the nation.

IF ALTERATIONS ARE MADE TO THE BUILDING OR THE CONDITION OF THE BUILDING CHANGES TO THE EXTENT THAT IT NO LONGER MEETS THE REQUISITE SPECIFICATIONS, THE RIGHT TO DISPLAY THE PLAQUE MAY BE RESCINDED AND THE PLAQUE REMOVED BY THE ORGANIZATION.
